## FREE Elder Law Services That Can Help You

The Houston Bar Association Elder Law program provides attorneys at several local senior centers throughout Houston. The attorneys are able to help you individually by answering legal questions, giving advice, and identifying specific legal problems. If a more detailed consultation is necessary, the attorney will assist you in applying for services through the Houston Volunteer Lawyers Program.

As a service to groups, the Elder Law program can provide a speaker at your senior meetings. Attorneys and judges familiar with senior issues and concerns are available to speak to your group at a time and place convenient for you.

The Elder Law Committee publishes a free, 50-page handbook that can answer many of your legal questions. The handbook is available to seniors, as well as centers and agencies that serve seniors.
